Audit Guideline (EMAD)

1. Introduction

The Audit is one option for completing the one (1) required Quality Improvement Activity for the EMAD.

The audit assessment task is for trainees to learn the process of a clinical audit and to analyse a relevant issue as part of an audit of the Emergency Department.

An outline of the audit cycle can be found in the trainee and supervisor handbooks.

2. Instructions

2.1 Trainees

- In consultation with the Primary Supervisor and in consideration of the criteria and descriptors on the assessment form, select a focus for an audit on an issue within the emergency department.
- Undertake the audit.
- Develop an audit report (1200 words maximum) and submit this to the Primary Supervisor. This report does not need to be uploaded to the ACEM Educational Resources site.

2.2 Primary Supervisor

- Use the criteria and descriptors where applicable on the assessment form to assess trainees' audit.
- For the Global Assessment, to be assessed as 'Competent' the trainee must not have been assessed as 'Not yet competent' for any individual criteria.
- Assessment (including feedback comments) can be recorded in hard copy initially, however, it also needs to be entered and saved in the assessment area of the ACEM Educational Resources website.
