### **Applications for grants now open.**

The objectives of the Rural Health Continuing Education (RHCE) program, funded by the Australian Government through the Department of Health and Ageing, is to provide education opportunities that support continuing professional development (CPD) for individual specialists as well as groups of specialists in rural and remote locations in Australia, with a focus on activities that encourage multidisciplinary team (MDT) - based learning.

Funding under Stream One of the RHCE is available to rural and remote medical specialists and specialist medical colleges to support these activities.

RHCE Stream One is divided into two distinct components:

1. grants for individuals accessing CPD (applications close Thursday 30th September 2010); and
2. grants for CPD projects (applications close 29th September 2010)

Please note that applications must be lodged via Specialist Medical Colleges.

Colleges may have earlier deadlines to enable a review of applications. College contact details are provided in the RHCE Stream One Guidelines for Accessing Project Funding.
