The position is fully funded under the Federal Government’s *More Doctors and Nurses for Emergency Departments* initiative. Infrastructure funding is available to set up a training facility. The successful applicant would be responsible for developing a training program in Emergency Medicine that satisfies the ACEM requirements for fellowship training and which permits Emergency Medicine Registrars to rotate to Calvary Health Care as part of their accredited training. It is expected that the program will create complimentary linkages between Private and Public Emergency Medicine.
