We are looking for enthusiastic post-CCT Fellows. This is a fantastic opportunity for someone to develop an area of interest within Emergency Medicine.

We are seeking to appoint doctors at Post-CCT level in Emergency Medicine to work at King's College Hospital's Emergency Department with special interests in Stroke Management, SEPSIS, Trauma and Medical Education. Details can be found in the JD.

You will be involved in delivering high quality care including stroke thrombolysis, non-invasive ventilation and the use of ultrasound in the ED. We have recently been nominated for trauma centre status and receive daily major trauma, including HEMS cases.

King's College Hospital is a major London teaching hospital. The Emergency Department sees over

120,000 patients in a state-of-the-art department serving a multi-ethnic inner city population.

These posts will commence immediately for six months in the first instance.

We run the following courses on site and can support you in gaining a place if necessary ALS, ATLS and APLS (subject to passing pre-course VLE), ultrasound guided central line placement, level 2 child protection, simulation training.

The posts will involve working a 24 hour rota to maximise exposure to major trauma, acute myocardial infarction and the use of ultrasound. The department is well staffed with F2, ST1-2, GPVTS and junior clinical fellow doctors who also cover 24 hour shifts. We have a strong presence of ENPs and GPs as well as a dedicated ED physiotherapist and MDT. The consultants provide shop cover seven days a week, including until 9pm on weekdays.
