We are looking for an experienced Career Medical Officer to provide effective emergency care to patients presenting to Emergency Department. Be involved in the clinical management of patients admitted to the Emergency Department, ICU or via Retrieval Services, which includes patient assessment, making treatment decisions, performing procedures and maintaining adequate medical records.

Purpose of the Position:

This position is a senior position at Tamworth Rural Referral Hospital in Emergency Medicine in which the position holder provides emergency care to patients presenting to the Emergency Department as required to inpatients in all general wards and ICU.

The position requires working a rotating roster, including weekends and nights. The Career Medical Officer (CMO) will participate in clinical duties as arranged by the appropriate Director of Emergency Medicine or delegate

Selection Criteria:

1. Medical degree and currently registered with AHPRA.
2. Recent acute care experience in a Base and / or Teaching Hospital.
3. Postgraduate clinical experience to include 3 to 5 years experience in Emergency Medicine within a level 4 or above delineated Emergency Department.
4. Demonstrates ability to work independently within a supervised complex clinical environment utilising skills, judgment and expertise to provide a high standard of patient care to all persons attending the Emergency Department.
5. Demonstrated high level of organisational, communication and interpersonal skills including the ability to consult with patients and their families, multidisciplinary health care team and broader internal and external stakeholders.
6. Demonstrated ability to work effectively as a member of a multidisciplinary team.
7. Demonstrated commitment to teaching and training of undergraduate and post graduate medical students and staff and non-clinical staff working in the Emergency Medicine / Critical Care area.
8. Ability to work in a computerised environment or preparedness to learn same.
