Motivated, enthusiastic applicants are sought for the posts of Clinical Fellow and Senior House Officer in Emergency Medicine in the Adelaide & Meath Hospital, Dublin incorporating the National Children's Hospital (AMNCH).

Successful candidates will join an exciting, dedicated Emergency Medicine team of 3 Consultants, 1 Senior Clinician, 2 Specialist Registrar, 6 Clinical Fellows, 11 Senior House Officers and 2 Interns. These posts are suitable for trainees in Emergency Medicine aiming to secure a post on the Emergency Medicine Specialist Registrar training scheme.

The AMNCH Emergency Department is the largest in Ireland with approximately 78,000 attendances each year. All trainees benefit from a consultant delivered formal teaching programme. Targeted training and supervision towards the MCEM and FCEM examinations is also provided. The AMNCH is the only hospital that hosts the MCEM examination in Ireland.

**ACLS**

Up-to-date ACLS certificate required for Adult Medical Registrars & SHOs, including Emergency Medical Registrars & SHOs:

The Medical Board of the Hospital agreed at it's meeting in March 2009, that the following NCHDs will require a valid ACLS certificate to ensure governance and competency on such rotas:

- All Medical (including Emergency Medicine) Registrars on the on-call rota for acute medical take, the rota for medical supervision of in-patients ('on for the house'), involved in carrying the cardiac arrest bleep, or in high risk areas such as ARHC/stroke-service, Cardiology, Respiratory, Renal, Emergency Department etc.
- All Medical (including Emergency Medicine) SHOs on the on-call rota for acute medical take or involved in carrying the cardiac arrest bleep.

This will be a requirement in the qualifications for all future posts, involving such rota work.
